



Instruction will be given on the presentation of the Practical Life exercises in the domains of grace and courtesy, care of self, and care of the community/environment


Adult learners will learn to present lessons in a manner that is developmentally attuned and engaging for the 3-6-year-old child

Presentation of curriculum will include materials for exploring:


- numeration from 0 to 9,999
